## Awareness–raising tools

### Overarching topics:

Document type	Resource	Description
Workshop	<a href="#">Climate Fresk</a> (EN)	Lasting between 3 and 3 and-a-half hours, the climate fresk is a workshop aiming to embed a better understanding of climate change's origins and implications. Can be completed remote or in person.
Workshop	<a href="#">2tonnes</a> (EN)	Workshop aiming to foster a systemic understanding of climate change mitigation and to provide participants with recommendations as to how to cut their individual emissions: in hopes of reaching 2 tons per person per year.
Infographics	<a href="#">Energy and Climate Intelligence Unit: Infographics</a> (EN)	Contains infographics about energy and climate, ranging from policy, to science, to economic implications. Informative, concise, and visually appealing tool to synthesise the fundamentals of climate change and its impacts.



Compendium	<a href="#">International Council for Voluntary Agencies: Climate and Environment Action Compendium</a> (EN)	Provides links to a wide range of resources and guidance to help tackle environmental resilience, climate change mitigation, and adaptation. These take the form of factsheets, research, event recordings, case studies, toolkits, legal frameworks, and more.
Short video	<a href="#">The Economist: See what three degrees of global warming looks like</a> (EN)	This short, 15-minute video exposes the impact on humans and the environment of temperatures rising three degrees over pre-industrial levels.

Flipbook	<a href="#">United Nations Sustainable Development Goals human impact stories: Bringing Data to Life</a> (EN)	Sheds light on the UN's SDGs in an anecdotal, personal manner. Recounts individuals' and communities' testimonies to raise awareness of the critical coalescence between human and environmental concerns globally.

Factsheet	<a href="#">United Nations Human Rights and United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees: Climate Change, Displacement and Human Rights</a> (EN)	Sheds light on how the impacts of climate change indirectly and directly affect human wellbeing and mobility, primarily for human displacement.
Seminars, podcasts, recordings	<a href="#">International Council for Voluntary Agencies Learning Stream</a> (EN)	Delves into practical ways to apply Charter Commitments through a lesson-based approach, focusing primarily on the threatening human implications of climate change.



# Trainings

## Self-paced trainings

Subject	Resource	Description
Fundamentals of climate change	<a href="#">Care Climate Change: Understanding the Climate Crisis</a> (EN)	<b>45 minutes</b> Provides a short, introductory training about the fundamentals of climate change, as well as its impact on vulnerable communities.
Humanitarian and environmental challenges	<a href="#">International Committee of the Red Cross's Massive Open Online Course on sustainability in humanitarian action</a> (EN)	<b>8 hrs over 4 weeks</b> Focuses on the interconnectedness of humanitarian and environmental challenges and provides help for the development of organisations' action routes. Utilises real-world examples of previous emergency situations (ie. Ebola outbreak) to better promote the integration of sustainability perspectives.
International solidarity sector	<a href="#">Coordination Sud: Connaître l'impact environnemental et climatique des actions de solidarité internationale</a> (FR)	<b>1 to 1:30 hrs per module</b> Composed of four online modules, evaluating the interactions between international project development and environmental repercussions. Provides knowledge on primary drivers of ecological change and enables reflection on action paths.



<p>Footprint, waste, biodiversity, supply chains, water, risk, and more</p>	<p><a href="#">Réseau Environnement Humanitaire: Bibliothèque des Ressources e-learning</a> (FR)</p>	<p><b>1h-1h30 per module (and 2hrs for certain webinars)</b></p> <p>Offers a wide range of specific, specialised modules to select from, some accompanied by pre-recorded webinars. Primarily focuses on environmental action in project management, contexts of crises, and overall sustainable development topics.</p>
<p>Sustainable development, circular economies</p>	<p><a href="#">United Nations Climate Change: Think, Talk, Act Climate e-Learn</a> (EN / FR)</p>	<p><b>1 to 8 hrs, depending on the selected topic</b></p> <p>Provides a wide range of classes with available certifications, primarily centered around sustainable development and green economies.</p> <p><i>Example:</i> <a href="#">Advancing Sustainable Development in Practice</a></p> <p>8-hour course concerned with the integration of sustainability within project development, including “analysis, dialogue, planning, financing, evaluation” and more.</p>



## Pre-organised workshops

<p>Green logistics, humanitarian aid</p>	<p><a href="#"><u>European Civil Protection and Humanitarian Aid Operation: Learning and Training</u></a> (EN)</p>	<p><b>4 hrs per training</b></p> <p>Includes a wide range of socio-ecological topics available for selection (ie. logistics, audits, financial management, humanitarian aid, etc.), and delves into these given themes in a 'virtual classroom' format.</p>
<p>Decarbonization: Financials, supply chains, action routes.</p>	<p><a href="#"><u>Carbone4: Our inter-company training courses</u></a> (FR)</p>	<p><b>15 to 20 hrs over the course of 1 month</b></p> <p>Utilises a hybrid format (video recordings, resources, collaborative spaces) in addition to virtual, live classes. Provides training on how to form a decarbonization strategy, assess risk, and calculate an organisation's carbon footprint.</p>
<p>Disaster risk reduction, climate change mitigation</p>	<p><a href="#"><u>RedR UK: Training and Learning for organisations and individuals</u></a> (EN)</p>	<p><b>1 to 40 days, depending on the selected topic</b></p> <p>RedR UK provides training related to climate change mitigation and adaptation on a regular basis.</p>
