



#### Climate Change Overview (1 of 2)








Climate change: A change of climate attributed directly or indirectly to human activity which results in the alteration of the composition of the global atmosphere, which observed over comparable periods in addition to the observation of natural climate variability

## Climate Change Overview (2 of 2)








- The public health sector is responsible for approximately 5% of Green House Gas emissions (GHG).
- 70 80% of GHG emissions is from Infrastructure within the health sector
- Health Systems do have an impact on the environment and climate change

- Initiatives and interventions that are sustainable and cost-effective



- Reduction of carbon footprint
- Promotion of public and environmental health.



- Race to Zero is a global campaign initiated by the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC)
- Mobilization of a coalition of cities, regions, businesses, investors, and universities to lead in net zero initiatives.
- Race to Net Zero invited health sector participation through the Health Care Climate Challenge.








- Primarily premised on the 10 GGHH Agenda Goals.




